About the Analyst Team of the Year Competition

The Analyst Team of the Year is a virtual challenge that celebrates analytical excellence. Returning with a new format for 2025, participants had a three-day window to complete the task. With all teams working from the same brief and dataset, the competition provided a level playing field for competitors to showcase their analytical expertise, problem-solving skills, and storytelling abilities.

This year, teams explored the NHS Payments to General Practice 2022/23 dataset, analysing how £4.4 billion in payments were distributed across England's GP practices. Participants were given a broad brief which allowed them to investigate factors such as urban vs. rural locations, dispensing vs. non-dispensing services and income distribution per capita. They were encouraged to uncover trends, anomalies and key insights that shed light on healthcare funding, delivering their findings in a clear, compelling and interactive report.
